
Presentation Guidelines

APCOT 2018 attaches much importance to the presentation quality of the speakers. Please take some time to read the guidelines below to ensure your presentation is successful.

- 1. Please arrive at the Lecture Theatre **10 minutes** before your session begins and report to the session chairs. We recommend that you will copy your PPT slides to the PC desktop in each Lecture Theater within this time.
- 2. All Lecture Theatres will be equipped with a computer, a video projector, a microphone and a pointing device. Each computer will have Microsoft Office and Adobe Acrobat Reader installed. You may also use your own computer for your presentation. We will provide the cables of VGA and HDMI ports. You need to bring your own converter if you will use other ports. Please contact the helpers on-site for the connection.
- 3. The time for each presentation is 15 minutes. We recommend that you will take about 12 minutes for your oral presentation and leave around 3 mins of Q&A.
- 4. Ten minutes after the oral presentation starts, helpers will alert the presenter and the session chair by raising the "2 mins left" card. Three minutes before the end of the prestation, helpers will raise the "Time's Up" card. At this point, please stop the presentation. Then the session chair will invite questions from the floor. At the end of the Q&A session, helpers will raise the "Time's Up" card again. Session chair should give no more than 30 seconds for the presenter to finish the sentence and move on to the next presentation/event.
- 5. **Lecture Theatre H** has been arranged as the speakers' room. The presenters could use this room for the preparation and testing of their slides, as well as the practice of their oral presentations.
- 6. Poster session will be held outside Lecture Theatre J. As the iCAN 2018 and APCOT 2018 sharing the same display boards, please understand that the time for setting up the posters can only from 10:30am June 25.

1. Wi-Fi.HK via HKUST (SSID = Wi-Fi.HK via HKUST)

This service is a collaboration with Hong Kong Government to promote the common Wi-Fi brand. Visitors can surf the Internet in public areas of HKUST campus. The service is free of charge and does not require any registration. In order to use this service, the users must agree to HKUST's Acceptable Usage Policy.

2. eduroam Wi-Fi (SSID = eduroam)

Education Roaming (eduroam) is an international wireless service, which uses IEEE 802.1X technology to provide free, easy, and flexible Wi-Fi access among education institutions around the world.
